When carefully researched and analyzed, Book of Mormon prophecies show how its end-time scenario consists of a series of concurrent events predicted by the prophet Isaiah that are still future. Drawing on different passages in the Book of Isaiah, Nephi, Jacob, and Jesus present variations on one theme—the restoration of the house of Israel. They identify the house of Israel as three groups of people: the Jews, Lehi's descendants, and the lost Ten Tribes. The spiritual kings and queens of the Gentiles play a key role in the house of Israel's end-time restoration.

A series of synchronized events—the Lord's "baring his arm"; the "day of power"; the Lord's servant fulfilling a mission to the nations; the gospel's turning from the Gentiles to the Jews, Lamanites, and Ten Tribes; their returning from dispersion in an exodus from the four directions of the earth; the destruction of the wicked; the deliverance of the righteous; etc.—characterizes the Book of Mormon's end-time scenario that is based on the prophecies of Isaiah. Only by taking all Book of Mormon prophecies together, not separately, does this scenario fully appear.
